

Toilets

At OSHC, we use the **toilets** inside the MPR building. We don't use the outside toilets. They are only used during school time.


The toilets are just off the kitchen dining area. The toilets are not are a play area. They are a private space and we respect people using the toilets.

Hand washing

Before we eat, we always wash our hands.

It's important that we use soap and water to stop the spread of germs. To stop the spread we also have sanitiser stationed for use at anytime.

Hats

We must wear hats outside in term 1 and term 4.


It's really important that you pack your hat during the warmer months.

Signing in/out

For before school care your parent or carer will sign you in via the QR code located at the Culloden Street entrance.

Carers will scan the code using their mobile phone/ other device and it will prompt them to sign in their children.



For after school care, we sign you in but your carers sign you out!



Before School Care Activities

After breakfast students can play outside on the first play ground, complete art and craft projects in the middle room or chill and relax with a good book. This is also a good time to catch up with your friends about your day.



Circle time

Circle time is where we mark the roll, talk about all the exciting things we have done for the morning and other important important things.

We sit in a circle on the floor and listen respectfully.

We mustn't talk while the roll is being called as the educator needs to listen very carefully for everyone's name.



Then, educators take students up to the school assembly area at 8.45am.





Before School Care

Arrival routine

On arrival in the morning, we first put our bags outside the MPR building inside the black line.



We then come inside and wash our hands in the toilets. Our parents and carers sign you in with the QR code. You then give them a quick goodbye and make your breakfast.

We often have Smoothies, Avocado toast or Pancakes, for breakfast





You can then choose from a variety of activities until it is circle time at 8.35am.



After breakfast, you wash your dishes in the tub and place them on the drying rack.

Breakfast


Breakfast is served from 7am to 8.20am.

We pack up breakfast at 8.30am so that you will have time to get to school.

We have a large variety of cereals as well as fruit bread and plain bread for toast. There are lots of lovely jams and spreads to try out.

We also add special treats on certain days, such as baked beans or yoghurt smoothies.

We encourage children to serve their own breakfast.




After School Care

After School routine

Educators will collect foundation students for the first term from their classrooms. Older grades make their own way to OSHC.

If you still need help, the educators will come and get you until you're confident!



It's REALLY important to come to OSHC straight away and not hang out in the playground. If you don't come straight away, we start to worry about you.

When you arrive at the MPR building, put your bags outside and come inside.

Foundies - go to the kitchen area

Juniors (Grades 1 & 2) - come to the MPR (Main room of OSHC)

Middles (3 & 4) - go into the Art room

Seniors (5 & 6)- go to the Library





After School routine Foundies

When the bell rings, we come straight away to OSHC.



We put our bags outside the MPR building, inside the black line.

We then come straight to the Dining room/ Kitchen of the MPR building.

We go to the toilets straight away and wash our hands with soap and water. We put on a vest and sit at the table for our circle time and wait for everyone else to arrive.



We listen to the roll and answer when our name is called. We participate in the welcome to country and listen to all the fun activities happening on the day.




We then use tongs to help ourselves to fruit snack.

Our second snack is placed on the table for us to serve ourselves.



When we have finished our meal, we wash our dishes and place them on the drying rack.

We then join in the fun!



There are lots of educators who can help you if you are unsure of what you would like to do first.

After School routine Juniors & Middles (grades 1,2 & 3,4)

We come straight away to OSHC from our school time.



We put our bags outside the MPR building, inside the black line.



We put on a vest and then sit in a circle and wait for our everyone to arrive. **Juniors** sit in the MPR.

Middles sit in the Art Room.



We listen to the roll and answer when our name is called.

We participate in the welcome to country and listen to all the fun activities happening on the day.

We are then given a dab of hand wash and line up to go into the art room or to the bathroom to wash our hands.

After we wash our hands, we go outside to eat on the outdoor dining tables.

We use tongs to help ourselves to fruit snack. Our second snack is placed on the table for us to serve ourselves.

When we have finished our meal, we wash our dishes and place them on the drying rack.



We then join in the fun of all the afternoon activities!



After School routine Seniors (grades 5-6)

We come straight away to OSHC from our classes.



We put our bags outside the MPR building, inside the black line.

We then head straight to the Library for roll call.





We listen to the roll and answer when our name is called.



We participate in the welcome to country and listen to the list of activities that will be happening on the day.

We then head back upstairs to wash our hands.



We then use tongs to serve ourselves fresh fruit from the platter. After our fruit snack we then eat the second snack of the day.



When we have finished our meal, we wash our dishes and place them on the drying rack.



We are mindful that being the Seniors of the school we are setting a good example for the younger year levels.

We then join in the fun of all the activities for the afternoon!

The dining room

We always eat fruit in aftercare along with another dish. The food is always vegetarian. We always offer dairy and/or gluten free alternatives for children who have allergies. We encourage children to try new things.

Helping each other in the Dining room

In the dining room, we use tongs to pick up our food.

We do not use our hands. This stops any germs.





After we have finished eating, we scrap our leftovers into the bucket for the compost. We then wash our plate in the washing tub and place it on the dishwashing rack.

Kitchen door.




Our inside spaces


The dining room


The dining room is where we come for all food related things. It is where the Foundies come to eat afternoon snack and where all have our breakfast in the mornings.

The dining room is where we host activities such as Cooking Club and Master Chef.

The kitchen is out of bounds to all students.









Our outside spaces

Our outside play areas are different to play time at school. There are different boundaries. Listen carefully at circle time as to which areas we will be using for OSHC and which areas are out of bounds.

We have Board Games, Magnetic Blocks, Magic Sand, Lego, Cars, Train tracks, Farm Animals,

Doll Houses and building blocks. We even have a Kitchen/Shop Corner. So many fun things to choose from!



The art room


Is where we do arts and craft projects.

Sometimes we go down to the oval to kick the footy or play soccer drills.




The basketball court
